3 **SECTION 1. TREATY SUBJECT TO ADVICE AND CONSENT OF**
4 **THE SENATE.**

5 Notwithstanding any other provision of law, any
6 agreement reached by the President with Iran relating to
7 the nuclear program of Iran is deemed to be a treaty that
8 is subject to the requirements of article II, section 2,

1 clause 2 of the Constitution of the United States requiring
2 that the treaty is subject to the advice and consent of the
3 Senate, with two-thirds of Senators concurring.

4 **SEC. 2. LIMITATION ON SANCTIONS RELIEF.**

5 Notwithstanding any other provision of law, the
6 President may not waive, suspend, reduce, provide relief
7 from, or otherwise limit the application of sanctions under
8 any other provision of law or refrain from applying any
9 such sanctions pursuant to an agreement related to the
10 nuclear program of Iran that includes the United States,
11 commits the United States to take action, or pursuant to
12 which the United States commits or otherwise agrees to
13 take action, regardless of the form it takes, whether a po-
14 litical commitment or otherwise, and regardless of whether
15 it is legally binding or not, including any joint comprehen-
16 sive plan of action entered into or made between Iran and
17 any other parties, and any additional materials related
18 thereto, including annexes, appendices, codicils, side
19 agreements, implementing materials, documents, and
20 guidance, technical or other understandings, and any re-
21 lated agreements, whether entered into or implemented
22 prior to the agreement or to be entered into or imple-
23 mented in the future, subject to the advice and consent
24 of the Senate as a treaty, receives the concurrence of two
25 thirds of the Senators.
