- 1 On page 6, after line 2, add the following:
- 2 **SEC. 7. ELIMINATION OF EARMARKS.**
- 3 (a) IN GENERAL.—Notwithstanding any other provi-
- 4 sion of any division of this Act—
- 5 (1) no amounts shall be made available for a
- 6 purpose specified in any table relating to congres-
- 7 sionally directed spending in the explanatory state-
- 8 ment described in section 4 (in the matter preceding
- 9 division A of this consolidated Act), or for any con-

1 gressionally directed spending in any division of this
2 Act, and each such item of congressionally directed
3 spending is null and void;

4 (2) each appropriation under any division of
5 this Act shall be reduced by the amount of any allo-
6 cation of such appropriation for congressionally di-
7 rected spending items that is made null and void by
8 paragraph (1); and

9 (3) each allocation of an appropriation under
10 any division of this Act shall be reduced by the
11 amount of any further allocation of such allocation
12 of an appropriation for congressionally directed
13 spending items that is made null and void by para-
14 graph (1).

15 (b) REPORT.—The Director of the Office of Manage-
16 ment and Budget shall submit to Congress a report indi-
17 cating the final amount appropriated for each appropria-
18 tion account for which amounts are made available under
19 any division of this Act and the amount of each allocation
20 of such an appropriation, as reduced in accordance with
21 subsection (a).
