1 At the end of subtitle G of title X, add the following:

2 **SEC. 1085. REQUIREMENT THAT THE INSPECTOR GENERAL**

3 **OF THE DEPARTMENT OF VETERANS AF-**

4 **FAIRS POST REPORTS ON THE INTERNET**

5 **WEBSITE OF THE INSPECTOR GENERAL.**

6 Section 312 of title 38, United States Code, is

7 amended by adding at the end the following new sub-

8 section:

1 “(c)(1) Whenever the Inspector General submits to
2 the Secretary a report or audit (or any portion of any re-
3 port or audit) in final form, the Inspector General shall,
4 not later than 3 days after such submittal, post such re-
5 port or audit (or portion of report or audit), as the case
6 may be, on the Internet website of the Inspector General.

7 “(2) Nothing in this subsection shall be construed to
8 authorize the public disclosure of information that is pro-
9 hibited from disclosure by any other provision of law.”.
